

President of the National Assembly Joined the 1st Meeting of the Reconciliation Committee

On Monday 18th January 2021, at 13.30 hrs., at the meeting room no. 419, 4th floor, Parliament Building, H.E. Mr. Chuan Leekpai, President of the National Assembly joined the 1st Meeting of the Reconciliation Committee with Hon. Professor Wanchai Watthanasap, acted as the Chairperson pro tempore of the committee meeting in order to select the Chairperson of the committee and set up the operational frameworks, and the meeting, then, elected Mr. Terdpong Chaiyanan to be a Chairperson.

At the meeting, President of the National Assembly stated another two parties, the opposition parties and protestors, did not propose namelist to be representatives in the committee. It would be, therefore, one of the accountabilities of the committee to coordinate with them demanding for their opinions and then make a discussion in the meeting. Not only the government and the opposition, but also all related parties have responsibilities to solve the political problems of the country.

In addition, President of the National Assembly mentioned the working principle of the parliament that adheres to the principle of the Democratic Regime with the King as Head of State and good governance. He, therefore, asked the Reconciliation Committee to adhere to the mentioned principle and do not distort the fact of matters. In case of agreed issues, the committee should proceed with the implementation. In case of disagreement, the committee should spend more time to consider. Moreover, he encouraged all committee members to continue working for the national interests and people.
